5.0	To Receive Brief Report from Three Crosses Ward Councillor Jonathan Lester					
	Ward Cllr Lester advised that Herefordshire Council are minded to increase Council Tax this year by 3.9%. Chancellor George Osborn has approved this increased percentage to all councils provided that 2% is ring-fenced for spending on Adult Social Care. This will raise a further £4.6m (£1.7m for Adult Social Care). Herefordshire Council currently spend £53m on Adult Social Care. Cllr Lester reported that an application for 28 homes in Stoke Lacy has been approved. Cllr Lester in his role as cabinet member for Children's Wellbeing had applied to Herefordshire Council for £600k to ensure that No1 Ledbury Road remained open for a further twelve months to provide families with respite care for children with special needs. He also stated that the number of looked after children in the county has risen from 270 to over 300 since his taking on this responsibility. School transport to the nearest school and catchment school has been reviewed by the scrutiny policy and the changes have not affected admissions. 50% of children do not attend their catchment school.
