	Ward Cllr Lester advised that in his role as cabinet member for Childrens wellbeing in February he launched Herefordshire Councils Capital Investment Strategy for schools in Herefordshire to try and future proof all schools in terms of both buildings and budgets by working together perhaps by sharing a head teacher and/or resources. He gave Broadlands Primary at Aylestone as an example of reinvesting in the countys education. However, the Secretary of State has issued the white paper Education Excellence for Everyone which will mean that the county council will have its assets stripped and funds handed to a government quango. Cllr Lester is having a number of meetings with our MP's as no academies pay business rates so this paper would have serious repercussions on Herefordshire Council. Herefordshire Council are also formulating the disposal process of its small holdings and has also had a request from Central Government to take on Syrian refugees, unaccompanied children and asylum seekers, the council is investigating its options and what is the best solution for all. An increased Council Tax of 3.9% has been agreed and bills issued to residents. Future elections are to take place 5 th May West Midands Police and Crime Commissioner and EU referendum on 23 rd June.
