4. To Receive a Brief Report from Three Crosses Ward Councillor, Mr Jonathan Lester

Ward Cllr Lester advised that there would be a Cabinet meeting on 1st December to review Hereford Transport package. £483k has been spent to date on the review and the best transport resilience, easing congestion and the western bypass. 59% traffic is trying to get to in/out or through Hereford. The capital and revenue costs of each package option put forward is to be considered by cabinet and a decision made on the best option to take. Herefordshire Council are undertaking a budget consultation with parish councils, probably the most challenging to date for making savings would it be right to raise council tax in these hard times. Also should Herefordshire Council build council houses to meet the housing demand borrowing money to make it happen (proposal 2500 over next ten years) or leave it to housing associations?
